



GETTING TO CAMBRIDGE, CAMBRIDGESHIRE, ENGLAND



From Heathrow, by underground train, train, Heathrow Express

Take the Piccadilly Underground Line to King's Cross station in London for 45 minutes, and then the train to Cambridge (around 50 minutes)

Or take the Heathrow Express, or regular Train to Paddington Station (around 20-30 minutes). Then take the Circle line underground to King's Cross station to catch the train to Cambridge.



From London Gatwick Airport

Take regular train that goes to Bedford, and stops at Cambridge.



From London Stansted Airport

Take the train or the coach (comfy bus) for 30 minutes to Cambridge.

Check for which airlines operate to Stansted:

There may not be a flight to Stansted from Paris, so take the Eurostar train to St. Pancras, which is across the road from King's Cross Station, where you can get a train to Cambridge. You can connect to Eurostar from anywhere on the European continent.

There is a flight from Paris to London City airport.

Coaches (comfy bus) to Cambridge

From Heathrow (2-2 1/2 hours), Gatwick (3 hours) and Stansted (30 minutes) you can take a coach directly to Cambridge (look up National Express).



Hire a Driver

If there are 2-4 of you it may be best to hire a driver to Cambridge which takes 90 minutes in good traffic. Drivers charge 120 GBP or more.
